Dear Breeders,

Horse Breeding is known as the “Dream Business” but for the majority of mares owners, it also has to be financially viable. The 2023 sales have demonstrated that where horses that fail to match strict criteria of pedigree and confirmation fall into a deep crack in the market. It is therefore very much in the interest of stallion owners and breeders to join forces to produce the horses that the market demands. We hope that the contents of our 2024 brochure will be of assistance to you in this regard by offering mare owners a mixture of proven stallions and some exciting new prospects.

In 2023 ACCLAMATION continued to be an ever deepening influence on thoroughbred breeding- now the paternal grandsire of 24 Group 1 winners of sons retired to stud in UK and Ireland and his daughters producing 11 individual Stakes winners this year. To add to the picture, we must mention his son, Romantic Warrior, recent winner of the Group 1 Cox Plate bringing his earnings to date over €11.5 million. To continue the Acclamation legacy, we were fortunate to acquire his fastest ever son, BOUTTEMONT, to join our roster for the 2024 season. He is retiring to stud sound of wind and limb after four full seasons of racing. He produced Timeform ratings of 110+ as a three, four and five year old which emphasises his soundness, durability and consistency. As a physical specimen, Bouttemont is a particularly good-looking and correct horse that bears remarkable similarity to his sire. We are confident that breeders will take all this into account and that he will have a very successful career at stud.

STATE OF REST took to his new role at stud with the same enthusiasm as he demonstrated on the racecourse. He covered a stellar book of mares from successful breeders with excellent fertility. We have received equally positive reports from Newgate Stud in Australia, where State Of Rest is currently on Southern Hemisphere covering duties. We are looking forward to his return in December.

2024 will be an exciting year for KODI BEAR with a quality crop of 2YO's set to represent him. Having seen how he upgraded his mares in his first season at stud. He was again so popular with breeders that he covered a full book of mares in 2023 which augurs well for the future success of his progeny on the racecourse.

Our National Hunt Stallion Roster for 2024 has been strengthened with the acquisition of the exciting JEU ST ELOI from France. This imposing 16.3 hands sire by Saint Des Saints is a half brother to five winners including dual Grade 1 chase winner Oculi and closely related to successful French sire Balko. Jeu St Eloi is currently the leading sire of 3YO hurdlers in France and is the sire of 10 NH Stakes performers to date from his first crops headed by Gr.3 3YO hurdle winner Kargese, who is now in training with Willie Mullins. We are confident that he will offer breeders a great opportunity to avail of new bloodlines at a reasonable fee.

BLUE BRESIL's outstanding rise through the stallion ranks continued in 2022/2023 season with Constitution Hill adding another four Grade 1's to his unbeaten record and Blue Lord, Good Land and Inthepocket all winning at the highest level.

SHIROCCO enjoyed another successful 2022/2023 season resulting in a career-best number of 14 black-type performers and sire of 131 winners.

YOUMZAIN has had impressive results from his first National Hunt crop of 4YO's in 2023 with several star and eye catching performers on the track and between the flags.

Looking to the future, our young National Hunt stallions, OLD PERSIAN and EAGLES BY DAY have been well supported by mare owners in terms of both quality and quantity. Therefore it makes sense that 2024 is the year to use them to capitalise on the quality of the stock they will have to run for them going forward.

We look forward to welcoming breeders old and new to Rathbarry & Glenview in the near future to discuss your mating plans for 2024.

A Living Legend

Acclamation's ever-deepening influence continues to expand as his progeny break new ground both on and off the track.

The late Liam Cashman's acquisition proved inspired when Acclamation produced a pair of Group 1 winners from his first crop; that achievement only bettered when both horses went on to become Group 1 sires. Now an established sire of sires, and an emerging damsire, Acclamation's own star shows no sign of waning, as demonstrated by Romantic Warrior's landmark Cox Plate victory.

Danny Shum's charge became the first Hong Kong-trained winner of the prestigious Group 1, and became the second ever to win an Australian Group 1. Michael Kinane, who selected **Romantic Warrior** as a yearling, later described the four-time Group 1 winner as "a rarity." The five-year-old's abilities are quite remarkable, in that he has won from six to ten furlongs, amassed over €11million in prize money, and never finished out of the first four.

It was perhaps unsurprising then, that an Acclamation gelding bred on a similar cross to Romantic Warrior was knocked down for 4,000,000 HKD (€470,000) at the 2023 Hong Kong International Sale. The purchase of Rathbarry's Acclamation colt for €280,000 by the Hong Kong Jockey Club at the 2023 Goffs Orby Sale headlined the strong demand for Acclamation throughout the sales season with buyers including Blandford Bloodstock, Peter and Ross Doyle, Donnacha O'Brien, Robin O'Ryan, SackvilleDonald, Dwayne Woods, etc.

Buyers were encouraged by Acclamation's smart juveniles in 2023, led by Group 3 winner **Orne** and a second stakes win for the highly rated French sprinter, **Bouttemont**, who will be looking to perpetuate his sires' successful line when he retires to Rathbarry for the 2024 season.

New For 2024

Rathbarry Stud are very proud and excited to add Bouttemont to our stallion roster for 2024. He will be the fastest-ever son of Acclamation to stand as a stallion and also his first son to retire to stud in Ireland since Mehmas in 2017.

Bouttemont was trained in France by Yann Barberot and has been one of the highest rated sprinters trained in France in recent years. His headline performances have come when winning the Group 3 Prix de Meautry (6f) at Deauville in 2022 and the Listed Prix Hampton (5f) at Chantilly in 2023, but that doesn't tell anything like the full story of Bouttemont's racing career.

The fullness of time revealed that Bouttemont's best trip was five furlongs and that he had a notable preference for fast ground. Having primarily raced on softer ground over longer trips, he only had limited opportunities in his optimum conditions.

Indeed, it was only as recently as June 2023 that he had the first chance of his career to race over five furlongs on fast ground in the Listed Prix Hampton at Chantilly, but it was a performance that proved to be worth the wait. He dominated a field of stakes winners to win by two lengths and stopped the clock at 56.18 seconds, an exceptional time for five furlongs anywhere in the world.

The only other time in his career that Bouttemont got his favoured trip and ground together was in the Group 1 Prix de l'Abbaye at Longchamp in October, but alas he finished hard on the bridle beaten just four lengths after being completely denied a clear run throughout the final two furlongs leaving us to wonder what might have been.

Bouttemont retired sound of wind and limb after four full seasons of racing. He produced Timeform ratings of 110+ as a 3YO, 4YO and 5YO, which emphasises his soundness, durability and consistency.



Kodi Bear was one of the sleeper hits of the 2020 freshman table, siring 18 winners from 53 runners in Europe at a useful strike-rate of 34 per cent, with a tally of five black-type

performers – Listed scorer Cobh and Group-placed Broxi, Measure Of Magic, Mystery Angel and Scarlet Bear – which outstripped his higher-profile peers New Bay and Shalaa...

Kodi Bear shone as a sophomore sire too, delivering 48 winners from 103 runners in Europe at a commendable clip of 47 per cent – some way off the second-season breakthrough New Bay on 56 per cent but on a par with the prolific Mehmias.

He put six black-type runners on the board that year, with Mystery Angel finding only Snowfall too good in the Oaks and Measure Of Magic running third in the Commonwealth Cup, and Go Bears Go, from his second crop of 61 named foals bred off a fee of €8,000, emerging as one of the best sprinting two-year-olds of the season...

Kodi Bear maintained momentum on the track throughout 2022, with Ever Given and Go Bears Go winning stakes races and Bergerac and Lucky Man developing into classy sprint handicappers...

Kodi Bear's smaller three-year-old crop has yielded 15 winners now, including Clounmacon, who took the Listed Sweet Mimosa Stakes at Naas last Wednesday, dual Listed third Lady Onyx and Lacken Stakes fourth Thunderbear.

Vain Gloria, another in this age group, is now unbeaten in two starts for Paddy Twomey after scoring comfortably in a slowly run median auction race at Cork on Friday. She looks capable of holding her own in better company, although the trainer reported that he is in no rush with her in the short term...

What I particularly like about Kodi Bear, and should keep buyers coming back for his yearlings, is that all bar one of his 12 runners with Racing Post Ratings of 100 or higher are the highest rated performers out of their dams. That shows he has not relied on mare power and has done it the hard way, to a large extent.

In some cases the difference in ability between Kodi Bear's best representatives and their siblings is quite stark.



All of which suggests that Kodi Bear could be that most priceless of commodities in the bloodstock industry: an upgrader of stock.

Upgrading his Mares

2024 represents an exciting time for Kodi Bear, with a quality crop of 2-Y-O's set to represent the Rathbarry Stud sire. Bred off the back of an impressive start by his first runners, the 2022 crop sold for up to 150,000gns at the yearling sales. Two of Kodi Bear's six-figure sales were bought by Alex Elliott, while other notable buyers included Highflyer Bloodstock, Peter and Ross Doyle, Stroud Coleman Bloodstock and Robson Aguiar etc.

Many of the purchasers had enjoyed previous success with Kodi Bear, with Sackville Donald having previously sourced Listed winner and Group performer **Ever Given**. David Loughnane trained **Go Bears Go** to win three Group races and place at Gr.1 level, while Nick Bradley and George Boughey enjoyed Stakes success with Epsom Oaks second **Mystery Angel**. Johnny Murtagh and Eddie Linehan are hoping for another **Measure Of Magic**, a dual Stakes winner and Gr.1 placed.

Clounmacon who won a Listed race this season was bred by Newtown Anner Stud, who were also among renowned the breeders to support Kodi Bear in 2023. Others included Airlie Stud, Ballylinch Stud, Ballyphilip Stud, Branton Court Stud, Corduff Stud and Rabbah Bloodstock, to name just a few. Breeders were no doubt influenced by Kodi Bear's commercial appeal, having been listed as the fifth most profitable stallion in 2022 by Weatherbys.

Kodi Bear's three Gr.1 performers are the first Stakes horses out of their dams and 2023 provided further evidence of how his progeny punch above their weight. Gr.3 scorer **Thunderbear** (OR 107) became the first black-type produce of his dam, with the same applying to the twice Stakes-placed **Lady Onyx**. Exciting juvenile **Room Service** (OR 102) looks sure to continue the trend after winning a £300,000 sales race for Kevin Ryan.



International superstar State Of Rest's Cox Plate form enjoyed a boost since his retirement when Anamoe won the 2022 running, having received 16lbs from Joseph O'Brien's raider in 2021. When State Of Rest returned in 2022 to beat three Group 1 winners in the Prix Ganay, he went on to record his fourth Group 1 success in the Prince Of Wales's Stakes at Royal Ascot with the runner-up Bay Bridge subsequently taking the Group 1 Champion Stakes and, thus, ended the unbeaten run of six-time Group 1 winner Baeed.

State Of Rest received a stellar book of mares from leading breeders in his first season at stud. He took to his new role with aplomb, covering 115 mares, boasting fertility of 86%.

There was an appropriately international flavour to the mares sent to State Of Rest, with support from renowned breeders not limited to: Ballylinch Stud, Brampton Court Stud, China Horse Club, Epona BS, Forenaughts Stud, Juddmonte Farms, Lanwades Stud, Niarchos Family, Rossenarra BS etc.

Among the 19 black-type mares in foal to State Of Rest is Love And Bubbles, herself a dual Stakes winner in France but now best known as the dam of Group 1 Japanese Derby hero Deep Brillante. She is one of 20 proven black-type producers carrying to State Of Rest.

Perhaps the most impressive statistic concerning the first mares in foal to State Of Rest is that over 50% are sisters of Stakes horses. They include 22 siblings of Group 1 performers, including Bateel, Emily Upjohn, Finsceal Beo, Hootenanny, Jacqueline Quest, Mehmas and Workforce. The Group 1 Cox Plate victor also covered a half-sister to Melbourne Cup hero Protectionist, an own-sister to Melbourne Cup 2nd Emissary and a three-parts sister to Melbourne Cup winner Almandin.



Breaking Records

Constitution Hill is an appropriate headline act to Blue Bresil's outstanding rise through the stallion ranks, as Nicky Henderson's star added another four Grade 1's to his unbeaten record during the 2022/23 season. A pair of wide-margin Grade 1 victories in 2021/22 saw the unbeaten hurdler achieve the highest rating ever awarded to a novice and he maintained this position 12 months later with a mark of 177p, making him the highest-rated British-trained hurdler since classifications were first published.

Blue Bresil also broke records in the sales ring this year, with Goldford Stud's filly out of Petticoat Tales becoming the highest-priced store ever sold in Britain at £210,000. At the Goffs Arkle sale Glenwood Stud's filly out of Houston Du Berlais was the top priced filly at €150,000. Blue Bresil's fillies were also in demand in France where Ballyreiddin & Busherstown Stud's filly realised €110,000.

Point-to-point handlers spent up to €100,000 on Blue Bresil's stores, evidently hoping for the sort of return achieved by **InthePocket** after his impressive debut for Paul Cashman. Subsequently sold to Michael Hyde for £290,000, the handsome bay repaid Henry de Bromhead and JP McManus with Grade 1 success at Aintree in April, as well as placing in another Grade 1 and winning a Grade 2.

Another Grade 1 winning novice hurdler for Blue Bresil last season, was Barry Connell's **Good Land** who impressed when winning decisively at Leopardstown his first time in Graded company. **Blue Lord** was another talented hurdler for his sire, having placed at Grade 1 level on three occasions, but proved a revelation over fences with three Grade 1 victories in 2022. Willie Mullins' charge was one of 11 black-type performers by Blue Bresil in 2022/23 - a personal best for the sire, whose first Irish bred crops will be 3YO's in 2024.

Glenview Stud's 2022 recruit Eagles By Day welcomed his first foals in 2023, with exciting Spring arrivals including a sibling to Ballycasey; foals from Grade 1 performers Jessbers Dream and Reine Angevine, as well as Graded chaser Solita.

In 2023 talented mares to feature in the second book of this high-class Group Winner included Galway Festival winner Our Kylie and six-time scorer Annie Other. Well-related mares who visited Eagles By Day in 2023, included siblings of Grade 1 performers Angels Breath and Monksland as did the sisters of Graded Winners Coole Cody, Mr Whipped and Minella Awards. The stallion son of Sea The Stars also covered a half-sister to Group 1 winner Fifty Stars (Sea The Stars) and Grade 1 winning hurdler Whiskey Sour.

At the time of writing, champion racehorse Sea The Stars is the sire of 21 Group 1 winners to date and was the leading Irish-based sire in Europe by prize money in 2022. His proven NH sons at stud include Sea The Moon, sire of dual Grade 1 winner Allmankind and Grade 1 hurdler Forever William, and Affinisea, sire of Grade 1 runner-up Affordale Fury.

Eagles By Day, of course, boasts further appeal to NH breeders through his dam Missunited. Mick Winter's star proved herself a top-class dual-purpose race mare as a six-year-old when winning the valuable Galway Hurdle, a Grade 3 hurdle and a Listed race on the flat, before finishing a gallant third in the Group 1 Prix Royal-Oak. But it was the following season that saw her win hearts, when making all the running in the Group 1 Ascot Gold Cup and rallying gamely to finish a close second to St Leger winner Leading Light. She retired a 12-time winner under both codes, including three Stakes wins on the flat and two black-type wins over hurdles.



New Bloodlines

Exciting French jumps stallion Jeu St Eloi joins the Glenview Stud roster for the 2024 covering season. The 12-year-old sire has been responsible for producing a number of eye-catching bumper, novice hurdle and PTP winners on both sides of the Channel.

His progeny began to make their mark in Ireland and the UK over the past 12 months, beginning with **It's For Me's** hugely impressive rules debut for Willie Mullins. The master of Closutton has since added two exciting 3YO fillies by Jeu St Eloi to his string- impressive hurdle debut winner **Karia Des Blaises** and Grade 3 winner and Listed-placed hurdler **Kargese**, who he hopes could be "a Triumph Hurdle horse."

Paul Nicholls is another trainer keen on Jeu St Eloi's progeny, having paid €175,000 for **Krocodile Rock** at the Goffs Arkle Sale. Nicholls is already responsible for Jeu St Eloi's unbeaten **Inthewaterside** who he describes as "a very smart prospect for novice hurdles" and talented hurdler **Blueking D'Oroux**, who following his winning seasonal return at Cheltenham in October holds an entry in the Greatwood Hurdle.

Among Jeu St Eloi's other runners to watch out for are **Saint Kristobal**, who produced a taking performance to win a 4YO maiden at Tattersalls, with Warren Ewing later describing the winner as "a little bit special" and **Jasmin Bellevue**, who sold to Highflyer Bloodstock and Nicky Henderson for £110,000 following his promising second at Dromahane for Denis Murphy.



First Foals in Demand

The foal sales provide the first test for a stallion's progeny and dual Gr.1 winner Old Persian's first foals passed with flying colours in 2022.

Gerry Hogan headed a list of shrewd judges who successfully secured a son of Old Persian's first crop, and a winning bid of €47,000 was required to procure the colt from the family of Cooldine offered by Ballincurrig House Stud at the Tattersalls Ireland November National Hunt Sale. After revealing that his purchase was made as a racing prospect on behalf of a client, Hogan said, "I really like the sire, he is a lovely son of Dubawi and has had some very nice foals here this week". Other notable buyers included Capital Bloodstock, Ferndale Stables, Redbridge Stables, etc.

The Bleahen Brothers regularly top the store sales and will be hoping to repeat the feat with Kevin Galvin's Old Persian colt, who they bought from Lough na Sollis Stud. The following month at Goffs, Hugh Bleahen added an Old Persian filly to his haul.

Smart first foals saw Old Persian rewarded with a stellar book of mares in his third season at stud. They include Grade 3 Fred Winter Juvenile Hurdle heroine Silk Affair (Barathea), whose resulting foal will be bred on a similar cross to Dubawi's Group 1 winners Arabian Queen, Hunter's Light and Monterosso.

Among the proven mares covered was Supreme Breda, dam of the three-time Grade 1 winner Beneficent and exciting point-to-point winner Leader In The Park, who sold for £250,000.

A number of well-bred mares are also in foal to Old Persian, including sisters to Grade 1 winners Bob Ollinger, Blackstairmountain, Kalashnikov, Watson Lake, Monkfish, etc.



A Career Best

Shirocco enjoyed another terrific season in 2022/23, resulting in a career-best number of 14 black-type performers. That figure was the third highest achieved by an active sire during that period, with the same title earned for Shirocco's seven black-type winners. Those accolades, along with a career-best 131 wins, saw Shirocco end the season as the fourth leading active sire by prize money.

Queens Brook set the tone early in the season with a comfortable Listed hurdle win before landing a Gr.3 at Punchestown. She ended the season with a fine third in the Gr.1 Mares' Hurdle at Cheltenham- her third placing at the highest level.

Willie Mullins is no stranger to success with Shirocco's progeny, having trained the great **Annie Power**. The master of Closutton worked his magic on **Shewearsitwell** to return to her best after a serious injury, as she recorded her second Gr.3 success at the Leopardstown Christmas Festival and rounded off a fantastic season with a gallant third in the Gr.1 Mares' Hurdle at the Punchestown Festival.

Olly Murphy meanwhile, appears to have a smart prospect on his hands in **Thunder Rock**, a previous bumper and four-time hurdle winner was seen to best effect last season when winning two chases and placed at the highest level to three-time Gr.1 winner Gerri Colombe.

There are a number of exciting point-to-point graduates by Shirocco to look forward to in the upcoming season, including John Costello's impressive Quakerstown winner **What's Up Darling**. The 5-Y-O subsequently sold to Gordon Elliott for a sales-topping £280,000 and went on to win a bumper in good style for Gigginstown House Stud. Tom Keating's promising 4-Y-O **Peso** provided Shirocco with another six-figure sale when knocked down to Jonjo O'Neill and Stroud Coleman for £100,000.



New Chapter

Youmzain's first National Hunt crop made a bright start in 2023, highlighted by impressive statistics achieved in Irish point-to-points. In the 2022/23 season the top-class stayer was responsible for 10 four-year-old runners in Irish points, two of which won, while another four were placed.

First to strike was Peter Flood's debut scorer **El Granjero** with the fastest time on the day (-16s) and was subsequently crowned the 'EBN Star Performer'. The following month saw **Harbour Highway** run out a five length winner at Bartlemy for Michael Goffs, who subsequently sold the bay to Emmet Mullins for £90,000. Cormac Doyle was another to profit from Youmzain's smart start, as he sold debut second **Laurens Bay** for £80,000 to Simon Christian.

Others to catch the eye included Donnchadh Doyle's well-backed newcomer **Little Big Kev**, who finished second at Ballindenisk. The Pat Doyle-trained **Le Coq Hardi** was another well fancied on debut and went on to finish a close third subsequently joining Henry De Bromhead, for whom he finished a promising third on rules debut.

At the 2023 store sales, Pat Doyle reinvested in Youmzain's stock and other notable handlers of three-year-olds include the Crawford Brothers, Francois Nicolle etc. Youmzain also has four-year-olds yet to run for Denis Murphy, Paul Cashman, Warren Ewing and the Colin McKeever/Wilson Dennison combination.

On the track, Noel Kelly appears to have a smart prospect on his hands in four-year-old bumper winner **Wrecking Ballbilly**. After finishing a close second on his debut, he was next runner up to Aughafatten who has now won three in a row and since Wrecking Ballbilly ran out a comfortable winner in Downpatrick.
