

Welcome to Rathbarry & Glenview Studs 2025



At Rathbarry we face into 2025 with mixed emotions as we have decided to retire our great servant ACCLAMATION after 21 years of outstanding service to the stud and to his shareholders. In 2024 his son, Romantic Warrior, won 4 consecutive Gr.1 races to add to his previous 4 wins at the highest level and his consistent daughter, Makarova gained a deserved Gr.1 win on her final career start in the Prix de L'Abbaye. He continues to be an ever deepening influence on thoroughbred breeding – his stallion sons, are now responsible for 27 individual Gr.1 winners around the world and his daughters have produced 19 individual Group winners to date.

To continue the Acclamation legacy, we were delighted to add his fastest ever son, BOUTTEMONT, to our stallion Roster in 2024. He is a particularly good-looking individual that is strikingly similar to his sire and has the same wonderful temperament. He was strongly supported by some of the most renowned breeders in the industry with a mixture of proven mares and daughters or sisters of stakes performers and his first foals are eagerly awaited in 2025. Given his first season support, he should have a great chance of starting strongly with his first crop of 2 YO's in 2027, so using BOUTTEMONT in 2025 could be a shrewd move.

The feedback from breeders on STATE OF REST'S first crop of foals 2024 from a quality book of mares has been very positive. He seems to be stamping his progeny with his excellent confirmation, quality and presence. His second book boasted another high proportion of proven stakes producers and sisters to black type performers and the support he has had from breeders to date underpins his position as one of the most exciting young sires at stud in Europe at this time.

In 2024 the ability of KODI BEAR to upgrade his mares was again demonstrated with the success of his Gr.2 Queen Mary winner, Leovanni, who is the fourth foal and only stakes performer from her dam and the Gr.3 scorer Cowardofthecounty, a fourth foal and sole blacktype horse produced by his unraced dam. These performances were not missed in the sales arena where his progeny sold for 170,000gns 160,000gns, 130,000gns, €165,000, €100,000 etc. and were purchased by some of the best trainers in the business.

For the 2025 season, in GLENVIEW STUD, we have an attractive roster of both proven and young stallions offering NH breeders a rich and diverse source of successful bloodlines.

BLUE BRESIL again attracted a full book of quality mares in 2024 as befitted a horse whose progeny have excelled on the track and have been in high demand in the sales ring. His first crop of Irish bred 4 YO's will hit the track in 2025 and with the quality and quantity of his mares steadily increasing since his arrival in Ireland, it would appear that his progeny will continue to be a force to be reckoned with in years to come.

We were delighted with the support that JEU ST ELOI received in his first season at Glenview Stud. Breeders were keen to avail of the services of the new bloodlines which JEU ST ELOI offered and with the success of his early runners on the track headlined in 2024 by the Willie Mullins trained dual Grade 1 winning filly, KARGESE, it augurs well for his future in this country.

In recent years we have invested in new bloodlines for National Hunt breeders viz EAGLES BY DAY by Sea The Stars and OLD PERSIAN by Dubawi. We strongly advise breeders to continue their support of these young stallions as both Sea The Stars and Dubawi are among the best sires of their generation and their sons are now having a deepening influence on thoroughbred breeding.

Thank you to all breeders for supporting our stallions in 2024 and we wish you a very successful 2025.

First Foals 2025

Rathbarry Stud are very proud and excited to have added Bouttemont to our stallion roster in 2024 to stand alongside his father Acclamation.

Acclamation will always be a legend in these parts and he continues to make a substantial impact on the thoroughbred breed through his own progeny as well as the ever-growing influence of his sons. Indeed, sons of Acclamation are now responsible for 27 individual Group 1 winners around the world, which prompted the Thoroughbred Daily News to opine that "Acclamation's record as a sire-of-sires is a statistical sensation."

Bouttemont received a stellar book of mares in his first season at stud which included proven dams responsible for the winners of Juvenile Stakes races Coventry Stakes, Dick Poole Stakes, Woodcote Stakes, etc.

Group 1 breeders that sent multiple mares to him include Aidan and Annemarie O'Brien (Whisperview Trading), John Bourke (Hyde Park Stud) and the Cantillon family (Tinnakill House Stud).

70% of Bouttemont's 2024 mares are daughters or sisters of Stakes performers including the siblings of Group 1 Winners Elusive City, Finsceal Beo, Mad Cool, Teona, etc.

His first book was strongly represented by leading broodmare sires Dubawi, Exceed and Excel, Invincible Spirit, Kingman, Kodiac, Lawman, Oasis Dream, Teofilo. Bouttemont's first book also included mares from the immediate families of Fine Motion, Invincible Spirit, Kodiac, Pilsudski, etc.

With Bouttemont having received such strong support in his first season, we are eagerly anticipating his first foals and welcoming his second crop of mares in 2025.



Upgrading his Mares

Kodi Bear's latest juveniles were bred off the back of his impressive start at stud and he rewarded supporters with two Group winners.

His latest two-year-old crop is headlined by Group 2 Queen Mary Stakes winner **Leovanni**, a £190,000 breeze-up buy who also finished third in the Group 2 Lowther Stakes. She continues Kodi Bear's reputation for upgrading his mares, as she is the fourth foal and only stakes performer out of her dam, herself a maiden on the track.

Group 3 scorer **Cowardofthecounty** backs that trend, as the fourth foal and sole blacktype horse produced by his unraced dam. Another juvenile of note is Jessica Harrington's filly **Kodilicious**, a winner over 5¹/₂ f who became the latest of Kodi Bear's black-type performers when closing late home to finish second in the Listed Bosra Sham Stakes at Newmarket.

Callisto Dream a two-year-old of 2024 who was an emphatic winner on her sole start was bred by Aughamore Stud, who were also among the renowned breeders to support Kodi Bear in 2024. Others included Ballyphilip Stud, Corduff Stud, Croom House Stud, Kildaragh Stud, Lodge Park Stud, Mountarmstrong Stud and Tinnakill House to name just a few.

The 109-rated **Room Service** leads Kodi Bear's three-year-olds on ratings, progressing from last year's success in the Weatherbys £300,000 2YO Stakes to finishing second in the valuable Coral Sprint Trophy on his latest start.

Kodi Bear remains as popular with buyers as breeders with his yearlings selling for 170,000gns, 160,000gns, 130,000gns, €165,000, and €100,000, etc. in 2024. Kodi Bear's success has increased his commercial appeal and he will be represented by 148 juveniles in 2025 giving us plenty to look forward to in the future.

First Yearlings 2025

Impressive first foals saw breeders send another stellar book of mares to State Of Rest in his second season at stud. Among those to support the accomplished globetrotter in 2024 were leading breeders Airlie Stud, Ballylinch Stud, China Horse Club, Epona Bloodstock, Lanwades Stud, Mountarmstrong Stud and Whisperview Trading, etc.


State Of Rest's second book of mares boasted enviable quality, with 16 of them already proven at producing Stakes horses.16 was also the number of black-type performers sent to the four-time Gr.1 Winner in 2024, dual Graded winner and multiple Grade 1 placed Martini Glass among them. 41% of State Of Rest's 2024 mares are daughters of Stakes performers, seven of them Group 1 winners or placed, including Finsceal Beo and Necklace.

Perhaps the most impressive statistic is that 75% are sisters of Stakes horses. They include siblings of 18 Group 1 winners in Almandin, Anmaat, Eldar Eldarov, Fasliyev, Jannah Rose, Menhoubah, Nayarra, Proctectionist, Shirocco, Signs Of Blessing, Siskin, Soviet Song, Talismanic, Thistle Bird and Zaaki etc.

This mirrors the strength in depth of State Of Rest's first book of mares in 2023, where 19% were Stakes performers, 20% were proven black-type producers and 22% were sisters of Group 1 horses.

State of Rest has been very well received in both his seasons down under where he covered two outstanding books as befitting a winner of the stallion-making Group 1 Cox Plate whilst defeating the Southern Hemisphere's best racehorse in Anamoe who carried 16lbs less and Horse of the Year Verry Ellegant.

"A living legend of the Irish stallion ranks"



2024 marked the end of an era at Rathbarry Stud, as Acclamation stood his 21st and final season.

The son of Royal Applause has exceeded expectations throughout his career, both as a racehorse and a sire. He was a Group 2 and Listed winner for Gerald Cottrell, but some could argue that his best performances came in defeat. At a price of 16/1, he separated Choisir and Oasis Dream in the King's Stand Stakes, despite breaking slowly and being denied a clear run a furlong from home. He stumbled at the start in the 2003 Nunthorpe, yet managed to finish third to the front-running Oasis Dream.

Those performances make you wonder what could have been, if luck was on his side, especially considering the talent he passed on to his progeny. His success as a sire was instantaneous, being crowned Leading First Season Sire due to his first crop producing Group 1 winners **Dark Angel** and **Equiano**, both of whom went on to sire top-flight winners themselves, the former set to be crowned champion sire for the 2024 season.

Ability, soundness and a will to win have seen Acclamation's progeny deliver time and time again, their long and fruitful careers echoing that of himself at stud. Of stallions who continue to cover at the age of 25, how many will be responsible for two Group 1 winners that same year?

On that note, James McDonald provided the perfect line after partnering **Romantic Warrior** to his fifth consecutive Group/Grade 1 win in the Yasuda Kinen. "He's got a heart of a lion and tremendous ability," the jockey said after Danny Chum's star registered his eight top-flight victory and 15th career win, bringing his earnings past the £15million mark.

Makarova is the most recent of Acclamation's Group 1 winners, the five-year-old having gained a deserved Group 1 win on her final career start in the Prix de l'Abbaye. She is likely not the last, either, if Acclamation's latest juvenile crop is anything to go by.





ROMANTIC WARRIOR

His two-year-olds include Queen Mary Stakes third Maw Lam, Stakes performer Assertively, Goffs 500 runner-up Mollie Foster and the 96-rated Last Encore. The future also looks bright for Angel Hunter, with Richard Hannon having described the 90-rated colt as "a horse for next year" following his win in a valuable race at York

Hannon, of course, is no stranger to success with Acclamation, and he chose one of Acclamation's sons as his favourite horse when interviewed by the Racing Post earlier this year. Overlooking his Group 1 winners, the trainer selected Oh This Is Us, saying: "He had the heart of a lion, loads of ability and was a pleasure to have anything to do with. Without a shadow of doubt he's my favourite horse and always will be." Hannon didn't even allow Oh This Is Us to leave his yard, retiring the now 11-year-old free of charge, following a career of 17 wins and over £700,000 in earnings.

Hannon isn't Acclamation's only fan, understandably, as was evident at the 2024 yearling sales. His latest offerings sold for up to 500,000gns, €600,000, and 470,000gns, their popularity producing a clearance rate of 90% during what has been a challenging sales season.

Even after his final crops have run their last race, Acclamation's legacy is ensured by his sons and daughters at stud. Dark Angel and Mehmas are his current leading lights of the stallion ranks, while his daughters have produced two Group 1 winners, another six Group 1 placed horses and 18 successful at Group 2 and 3 level.

The Cambridge Dictionary defines acclamation as 'public approval and praise,' an appropriate name for a stallion who has provided good fortune to many a breeder, owner, trader and trainer.

Blue Bresil's incredible rise through the stallion ranks attracted perhaps his best book of mares in 2024. Among those scanned in foal to the Glenview Stud sire were six Gr.1 winners with an incredible 32 top-flight victories between them, led by wonder mares Honeysuckle and Apples Jade.

Fifteen Gr.2 and 3 winners were also scanned in foal, along with eight Listed winners, two of them Gr.1 placed. They were joined by a number of proven producers, including the dam of Douvan and Jonbon.

The quality of his most recent books is even more exciting considering his history of upgrading mares - 7 of his 8 Gr.1 winners **Blue Lord, Constitution Hill, Good Land, Inthepocket, L'Autonomie, Mick Jazz** and **Redemption Day** are the only black type produce of their dams.

Constitution Hill, regrettably, ran just once last season, but Nicky Henderson's seven-time Gr.1 winner remains unbeaten under rules and still holds the title of the highest ever rated novice hurdler and the top British-trained hurdler in the last quarter of a century.

We look forward to his seasonal return, along with that of Willie Mullins' Gr.1 Punchestown Champion Bumper victor Redemption Day. Henry De Bromheads' Gr.1 winning Novice Hurdler **Inthepocket** has made an impressive seasonal return over fences when defeating fellow Gr.1 scorer Farren Glory by 15L. Others to catch the eve at the start of the 2024/2025 season include a trio of 5-Y-O's. Pony Soprano, Sunray Shadow and The Kemble Brewery all convincing winners over hurdles in October with the two latter also being bumper winners. 4-Y-O's to enter the notebooks are Tom George's Full Force Gale and Dan Skelton's **Blue Carpet** both of whom were impressive bumper winners in October on debut, with the latter being a full brother to Listed hurdle winner and multiple Graded placed Yosille.



Gr.2 winner and Gr.1 runner-up Jessber's Dream is the highlight of mares scanned in foal to Eagles By Day in his third season at stud. The talented mare's first two foals through the ring have both fetched \notin 65,000.

Annie Spectrim was another proven producer sent to Eagles By Day this spring, with her four winners including John Nallen's unbeaten 4-Y-O Minella Hollow. Other well-related mares scanned in foal to the son of Sea The Stars include sisters to Gr.1 winners Death Duty, On The Go, Prince Of Scars and Waiting Patiently.

Breeders who have enjoyed previous success with Glenview Stud stallions sent sisters to dual Gr.3 winner Rock The Kasbah (Shirocco) and multiple Graded-winning chaser Coole Cody (Dubai Destination).

Quality mares is a running theme through Eagles By Day's first three book of mares, having covered the aforementioned Jessbers Dream, fellow Gr.1 performer Reine Angevine and Graded chaser Solita in his debut season.

Eagles By Day's own pedigree has also enjoyed a fine few months, with his half-sister Wholeness winning a Listed race and placing in a Gr.3 this year, whilst a Lope De Vega yearling out of an own sister to Eagles By Day realised 280,000gns when purchased by Stroud Coleman Bloodstock at Tattersalls Book 2. His all-conquering sire Sea The Stars also looks set for his best year so far, as at the time of writing in mid-October, he is responsible for 13 Group winners- one shy of his career-best.

They include Gr.1 Grand Prix de Paris victor and Prix du Jockey Club third Sosie- he one of eight by the sire to have won or placed at the highest level in 2024. Sea The Stars is also represented by Willie Mullins' exciting recruit Sea Of Sands, who made a winning hurdle debut at the Listowel Harvest Festival.



A Career Best

Jeu St Eloi's first season at Glenview Stud coincided with a career-best season on the track for his progeny, in terms of winners, prize money and black-type performers.

33 winners from 91 runners matched the previous period's impressive strike rate of 36%. In France, he boasted a strike rate of 37% in 2024, bettering that of his own sire Saint des Saints, as well as Martaline, Kapgarde, Great Pretender and No Risk At All, to name just a few.

The 2023/2024 season also saw Jeu St Eloi responsible for his highest-rated runner in the UK to date, Paul Nicholls' Grade 2 Coral Hurdle victor **Blueking d'Oroux**. Nicholls is also responsible for the sire's Grade 3 performer **Inthewaterside**.

The star of last season, though, was Willie Mullins' dual Grade 1 winner **Kargese**, who finished second on both her other starts at the highest level. She, along with Grade 2 winning chaser **Krokodile Dundee** and Grade 3 runner-up **Kel Espoir En Jeu**, contributes to another impressive statistic, in that 12.5% of Jeu St Eloi's current four-year-old runners are black-type performers.

The effects of a fantastic season were felt at the 2024 store sales, where a median price of €56,000 was attained from buyers such as Gordon Elliott, Highflyer Bloodstock, Tom Malone, Paul Nicholls, Ian Ferguson, Cobajay Stables and Warren Ewing.

These results will have been celebrated by the many breeders who supported Jeu St Eloi in his first season at Glenview Stud. A book of mares brimming in quality included 32 blacktype performers, such as dual Grade 2 scorer and Grade 1 second Gazelle d'Authie, and Grade 1 winner Augusta Kate. Other proven producers scanned in foal to Jeu St Eloi were the dams of Fury Road, Lalor, Magical Zoe and Slade Steel, as well as own-sisters to Put The Kettle On and The Tullow Tank.



The dual Gr.1 winner's first foals sold for up to \notin 47,000 in 2022 and his second crop bettered that last November, when a colt bred by Pollards Stables was knocked down to Kevin Ross for \notin 60,000 at the Tattersalls Ireland November NH Sale.

After signing, the agent said: "We really wanted one by the sire. We love the line, Old Persian is by Dubawi which we are keen on, and he was a tough campaigner who won nine races around the world. We had to push the boat out, but he is a lovely type."

The colt is one of two Old Persians bought by Ross, while others to have invested in the sire's first crops include the Bleahen Brothers, Capital Bloodstock, Mount Eaton Stud, Redbridge Stables, Richard Rohan, etc.

Old Persian's fourth crop of foals looks set to continue his bright start, with returning Grade 2 chaser Oh Me Oh My among the mares scanned in foal. His latest book also included proven producers such as Inch Native, whose two runners to date are Grade 2 winning novice hurdler Mossy Fen and the twice Grade 3 placed Media Naranja.

Pedigree highlights of the mares scanned in foal are sisters to Grade 1 winners Backspin, Commander Of Fleet, Jessies Dream and Monalee, as well as Aintree Grand National hero Pineau De Re.

Old Persian boasts a fine pedigree himself, hailing from the top-class family of Miesque, and his sire Dubawi needs no introduction. The most successful sire to ever stand in Britain, he has sired 60 Group 1 winners to date, while his sons New Bay, Night Of Thunder and Too Darn Hot have had sensational starts to their stallion careers.
